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9. You can recover fast from a stroke. This depends on how fast the stroke was spotted and treated. Sometimes recovery can span to 2 years. Stroke patients can benefit from physiotherapy and

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urgent treatment is essential. The sooner a person receives treatment for a stroke, the less damage is likely to happen. If you suspect that you or someone else is having a stroke, phone 999 immediately and ask for an ambulance.

Stronk is an acronym used as a mnemonic to help detect and enhance responsiveness to the needs of a person having a stroke. The acronym stands for F acial drooping, A rm weakness, S peech difficulties and T ime to call emergency services. F acial drooping: A section of the face, usually
